Race 2 - Pick 4

#5 Economic Hangover – Ready off the works; drops into a win spot off the bench
#3 Cloudy Bay – Lost all chance at the break last out; has run races that make her a contender here
#2 More Than Glory – Has done her best work on turf; rates high in first run for a claiming tag

Race 3 - Pick 4

#3 Hashtag Winner – Despite the cut back & the lack of speed signed on, she remains the one to beat #6 Charge Account – Boasts five wins on dirt & has been facing tougher than this of late #4 Duplicitous – Earned a circumstantial win last out; the way this race shapes up it could happen again

Race 4 - 20-Cent Jackpot PK 6 c/o = \$773

#8 Excellent Question — Excuse recent slop clunker; a repeat of her previous efforts get the job done here #1 Call Again — Eliminated at the start on debut; deserves another chance in this one #2 Flashy Lass — Even effort on debut, but aggressive connections elect not to drop in class for second try

#2 Wonder Wave (Ire) – Hard charging third behind super talented top pair on debut; her race to lose #4 Rainy Night – Her dam has been a solid producer; ready off the works for solid operation #7 Big Dreamer – Bred for turf top and bottom; watch the tote for clues

#9 Northern Flame – The "other" McPeek should take a big step forward in career start number 2 #2 Generous Tipper – Ran a monster race to finish 2nd at this trip last out; squarely the one to beat here #6 Dynamis -- \$875K OBS April RNA has the look of a real runner; would be foolish not to include

#7 F Five – Has speed, talent & has proven he can handle distance; squarely the one to beat #9 Kitten Mischief – Welcome return to turf; may be left with too much to do #4 Founder – Certainly capable with A-game, but he is being dangled for a claiming tag

#2 Insignia – Could be stakes caliber; looks like an absolute free space here

#11 Mikita – Eliminated at the start in last; his dam won four races on the grass#4 Ziggzappa – Stretches out off needed run; turfy
